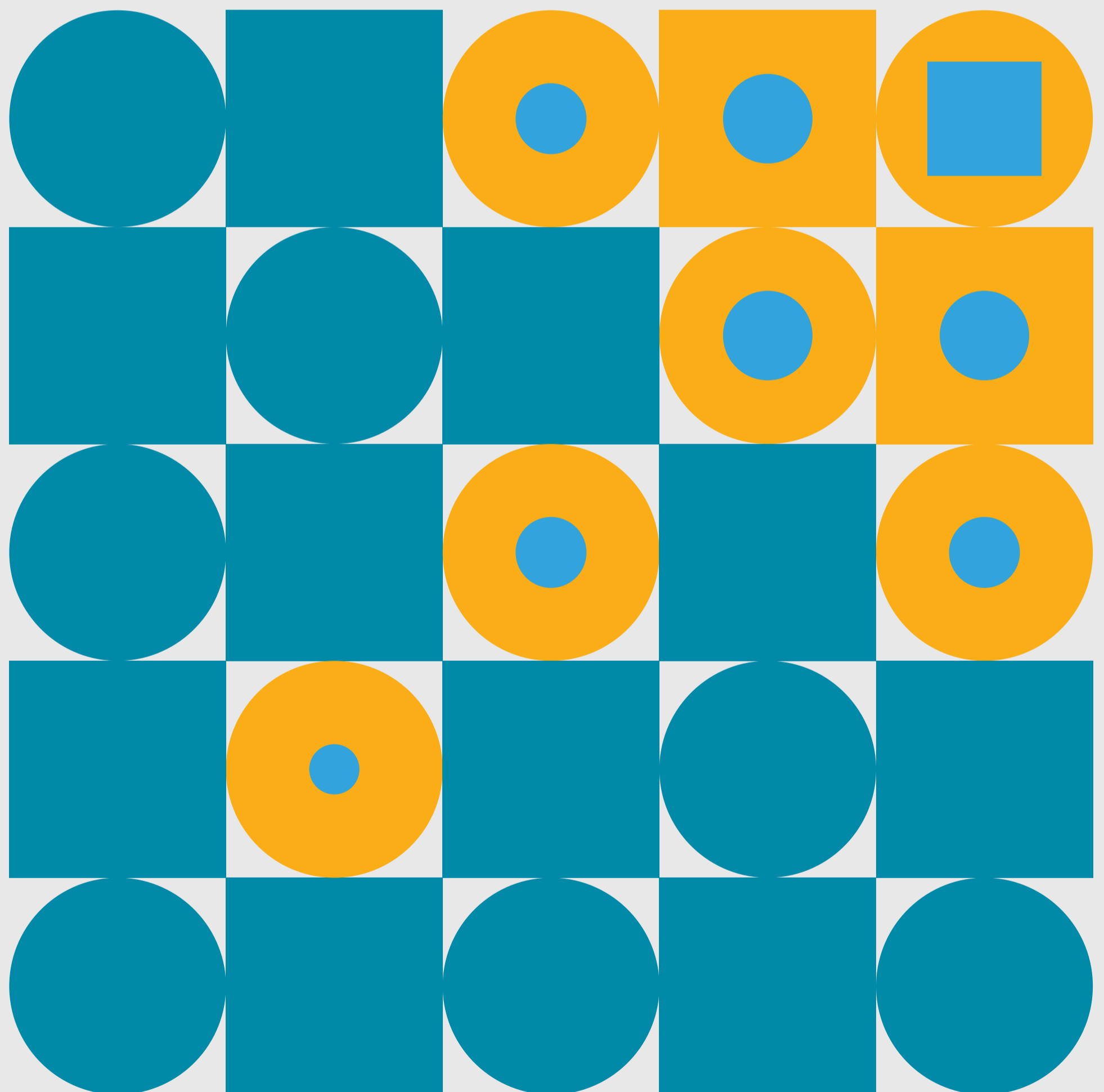

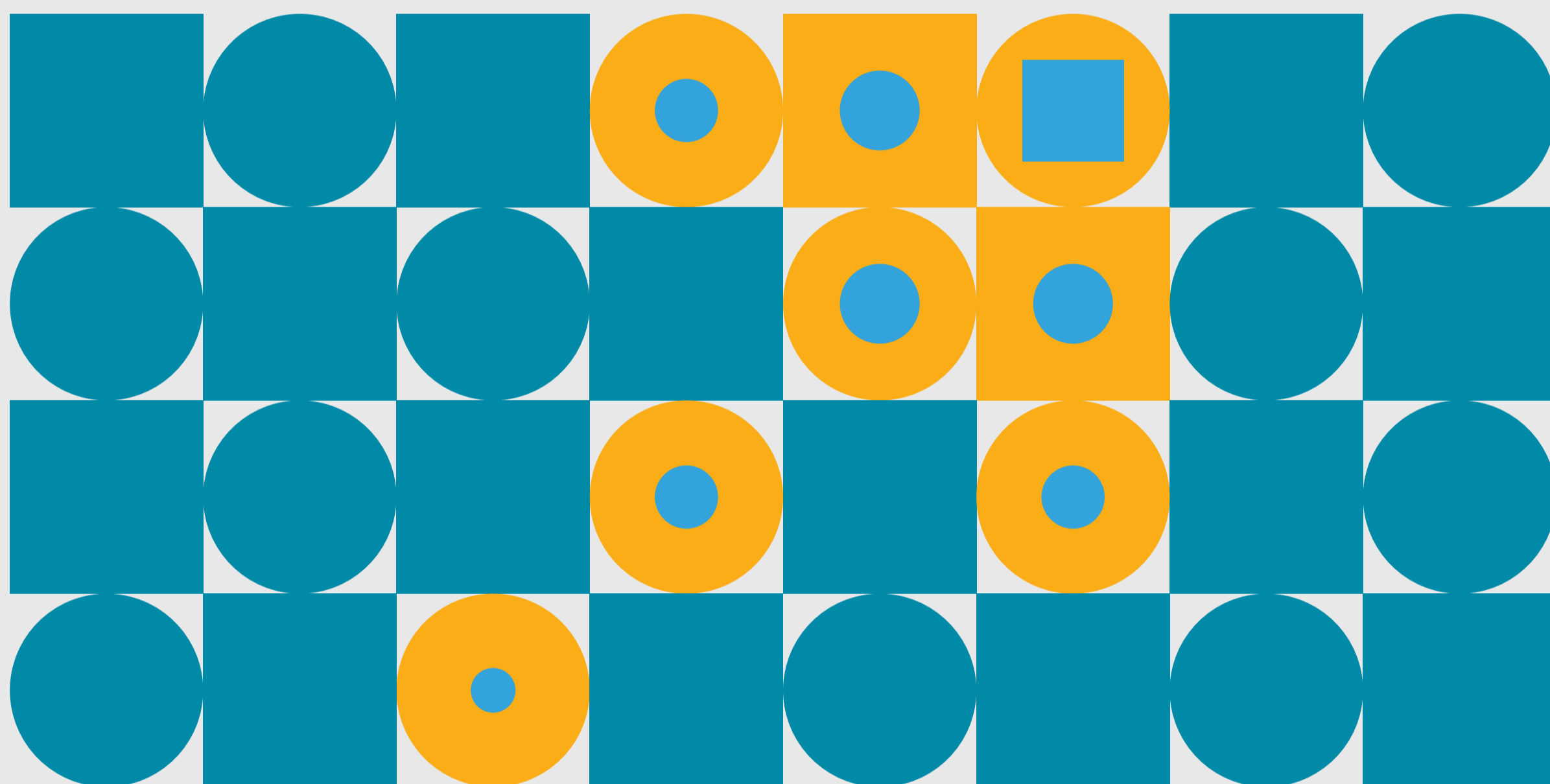

Introduction

Dear Guests,

At the dawn of a new era for Europe, the years to come will be crucial in managing, continuing, and evolving the significant work accomplished in cancer care and treatment thus far. Civil society representatives, acting as the connecting link, are called upon to play a new role. This role will robustly support the implementation of health policies focused on a people-centred perspective and guarantee equitable access to a sustainable healthcare environment.

In recent years, the landscape of cancer care has undergone a profound transformation. The launch of Europe's Beating Cancer Plan, in conjunction with the Cancer Mission, has provided the necessary impetus for action, while also offering the required support for member states' endeavors to revamp their cancer care systems operation. Currently, 20 out of the 27 member states have unveiled their national action plans and are taking concrete steps. However, the momentum, driven by the vision and dedication of the European Commissioner for Health and Food Safety, Stella Kyriakides, must be sustained and intensified in the years to come.


One crucial lesson we've learned is that forging synergies and leveraging data and experiences, in tandem with political resolve, are pivotal for effecting real reform. This entails harnessing and translating research initiatives into clinical practice, with the ultimate goal of achieving timely detection and optimal management of cancer, thereby bolstering survival rates.

In recent years, Greece has made remarkable strides in cancer care, with a strong focus on prevention and public health. It has spearheaded the development of screening and vaccination programs and has already initiated a significant digital transformation project in oncology care. This ambitious project involves the digitization of twelve oncology hospitals and clinics, the establishment of a National Cancer Registry, and the creation of a digital application to facilitate optimal access to medical information and patient management, taking into account their unique experiences and preferences.

Following the Minister of Health's announcement four months ago about the creation of a National Cancer Action Plan, the Hellenic Cancer Federation, in alignment with its vision, is taking a significant step. It is organizing the 1st Greek Forum on Cancer Policy, Research, and Funding Strategies. This forum serves as a powerful testament to the importance and urgency of implementing an operational strategy to support the development of the national plan.

Furthermore, following the end of the economic adjustment period in our country, developing a medium-term trust agreement between the state and all stakeholders involved in cancer care is essential for implementing necessary adjustments. This will lead to better utilisation of existing resources and the search for and allocation of new ones, which are needed and can act as a catalyst for positive developments that will accelerate procedures.

The upcoming digital transformation, coupled with the implementation of Artificial Intelligence and the European Health Data Space, signifies significant impending changes in the healthcare sector. There is a growing need for interoperability and connectivity at the European level, as well as the adoption of standard European formats. Additionally, researchers' access to underutilised data presents opportunities for clinical studies, while ethical concerns also need to be addressed and have already been included on the agenda.

In closing this brief introduction, I would like to express my warm thanks to the National Documentation Center and Dr. Sophia Xesfingi, National Contact Point Horizon Europe (Cluster Health, Cancer Mission), Innovation & Research Consultant, for co-organizing the Synergies of EBCP & Cancer Mission session and for their excellent cooperation, unwavering support, and assistance.

I would also like to extend my heartfelt thanks to all the distinguished guest speakers who honour us with their presence, travelling from all corners of our country and throughout Europe to participate in this significant and pivotal event for us and, we believe, for our country.

With these thoughts and the belief that you will find the program and sessions very useful and exciting, we welcome you to the 1st Greek Forum on Cancer – Policy, Research & Funding Strategies and look forward to your active participation.

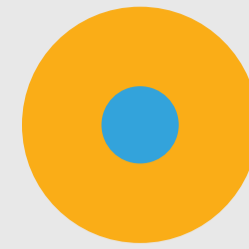

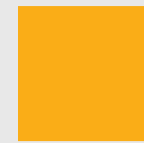
